

SELINGROVE'S MARKET STREET MANOR AND HIGH STREET MANOR ELDERLY APARTMENT COMPLEXES

Applications are being accepted from eligible individuals and couples age 62 and older who wish to rent a one-bedroom apartment at Market Street Manor, 342 South Market Street, Selinsgrove, or High Street Manor, 441 South High Street, Selinsgrove, Pennsylvania. WHAT ARE THE MARKET STREET MANOR AND HIGH STREET MANOR COMPLEXES?

Market Street Manor consists of 17 individual living units, and High Street Manor has 25 individual living units, designed to house senior citizens 62 years of age or older. These apartments offer modern, maintenance-free, and affordable living. All of the apartments consist of a combined kitchen/dining area, living room, bedroom, and bathroom. The facilities also have luxuriously-furnished community spaces located throughout. These spaces include a community room, sitting lounges, and a three-season porch.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Individuals who are at least 62 years of age and whose annual incomes are at or below \$23,400 for one-person households and \$26,700 for two-person households.

HOW MUCH RENT DOES A RESIDENT PAY?

\$510 for a one-bedroom apartment. The monthly rental includes all utilities with the exception of cable television and telephone.
